They enjoy a number of adventures during this time although there appears to be a certain strain in the relationship which we see through the eyes of the adult Sophie when she looks back on what was possibly the last time she spent with her loving father.

Adapted from a 2016 novel by Paolo Cognetti, this is an epic journey of self-discovery following their friendship over four decades set against the backdrop of the Italian Alps. Set in Baghdad against a background of sectarian violence during the winter of 2006, this film tells the stories of ordinary Iraqis trying to live their everyday lives in the city, despite unpredictable violent events, which put them in peril. Sara, a single mother and novelist, now translates letters for a living while keeping track of the attacks in the city. Her story is interwoven with those of her neighbours, other ordinary Iraqis who are also trying to live their respective lives.

The film follows the South London lives of Travis, fresh out of prison, his partner Candice, a singer, and their secretive teenage daughter, Kenisha. This is a slow-burn drama brimming with humanity, love and the energy provided by the soundtrack of iconic Tina Turner hits.
